OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

FIRE AND EMS SHOW is owned and operated by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and is referred to in these rules as "the show". The following are the Rules and Regulations in assigning display spaces, as well as governing occupancy and use of exhibits and related conditions:

1. APPLICATIONS:

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

The show reserves the right to accept or reject any application for exhibit booth(s)/space. Unless management has made an exception, all applications must be accompanied by a 50% deposit for space requested. You will be assigned space and sent a confirmation noting your space.

2. CANCELLATION OF DISPLAY SPACE:

Any exhibitor cancelling booth(s)/space 60 days before show date is responsible to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. for the full participation fee for the space requested and/or assigned. In the event space is requested 30 days before the show date, the exhibitor is responsible for the full participation fee upon issuance of the confirmation of space order and accompanying invoices. Because these dates are related to the show date and not the date of this agreement, these dates and percentages shall apply regardless of the date on which this agreement is executed. This amount is considered to be liquidated and agreed upon damages as a bona fide provision and not a penalty. The parties understand that the withdrawal of the space reserved from availability at a time when other parties would be interested in applying for it, will cause LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. will be substantial but they will not be capable of determination with mathematical precision. Therefore, the provisions for liquidated and agreed upon damages have been incorporated into this agreement. The right is reserved by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. of cancelling or closing of space assigned upon the violation of any of these rules or by the existence of any condition not previously known to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. with no legal liability whatsoever to be incurred by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. except for the refunding of any participation fees received for the space if the trade show is cancelled prior to the commencement date and with no liability to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. if the closing of the display space is caused in whole or in part by the participant's violation of these rules or by the existence of a condition not previously known. Likewise LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. reserves the right to reassign comparable display space to Exhibitors in the event space previously assigned to an Exhibitor is not available for any reason whatsoever.

4. PARTICIPATION FEES:

Official participation fees must be paid by exhibiting firms to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. in accordance with the schedule of rates listed on the application and the rules stated herein. This application must be accompanied with your check for 50% of the fee made out to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. Exhibitors will be invoiced for the balance.

- A) 50% at time of application
- B) Balance to be paid 30 days prior to show date

LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. without prior notice to exhibitors expressly reserves the right to modify, supplement, and/or to change the OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, as they deem necessary, and required for the efficient operation of the show, and to protect LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and from any liability whatsoever arising from any acts or conduct of omission or commission by Exhibitors, their agents, guests, customers, visitors, etc.

5. NO SUB-LETTING OF SPACE:

No sub-letting or sharing of display space will be permitted. Violations will result in removal from the exhibit floor without any refund of any fees paid or expenses incurred by exhibitor.

6. REQUEST FOR SPACE ADJOINING OR NEAR OTHER EXHIBITOR:

Specific requests to be assigned display space adjoining or near other Exhibitors will ONLY be considered when both firms involved submit written application and providing space is available. Exhibitors specifically requesting NOT to be near a particular company must also advise LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. in writing upon submission of the application. In the event this request cannot be accommodated, LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. will bear no liability for its inability to comply with the requests.

7. MOVING OF EXHIBITS:

No exhibit shall be moved from one location to another after set-up time is added. Assigned space is not contingent on location of Show entrances or exits, food concessions or attractions. It is agreed that assigned space is final and may not be changed once the show is open, except at the request and/or approval of LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. wherever and if possible.

8. EXCLUSIVITY:

No sales exclusivity or merchandise, type of merchandise or name brands is extended to any exhibitor in this agreement unless separately negotiated with LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and such exclusivity is requested on the official application and formally approved in writing by management of LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC.

9. DIRECTORY LISTINGS:

The official directory is a complimentary and discretionary service of LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and every reasonable effort will be made to make it accurate, but LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. takes no responsibility for any inaccuracies or omissions. After publication, additions or corrections cannot be made in the Directory. Directory listings cannot be provided or changed one week before show date. Exhibitors are reminded there will be no supplement to the Directory.

10. LIVE DEMONSTRATIONS AND ENTERTAINMENT

Exhibitors shall not conduct activity of any kind that leads to congestion or aisle traffic. Noise, music, live or recorded and announcements that are considered objectionable by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. are not permitted. Exhibitors and their representatives shall not congregate or solicit trade in the doorways or aisles. All doors and/or corridors shall be left open during Exhibit hours. No live models, demonstrations or solicitations of any kind are permitted in the aisles. Exhibitors desiring to utilize music from tapes, record, CD's video or radio (over speakers), live presentation, or any other source, which require permission from the composers, song writers, and publishers of this music shall be responsible for obtaining such permission and/or paying any fees attributable to same. Exhibitors

desiring to distribute novelties, prizes, pamphlets, brochures or any other advertising matter must see that such distribution be confined to the individual exhibit space. If food or refreshments are to be served, the Exhibitors must use the official building food service contractor. Exhibitors shall not lead buyers from one space to another. No Exhibitor or any of his representatives shall conduct himself in a manner offensive to the standards of decency or good taste.

11. FIRE REGULATIONS

Compliance must be had by Exhibitors with rules and regulations of the local Fire Department and the Fire Codes of the State of New York. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, only decorating material which has been approved by the Fire Department Regulations. Exhibitors must make certain that decorators engaged comply with said rules and regulations. Any decorator selected by an exhibitor, before being permitted to decorate any exhibit must first submit to official show decorator a verified certificate must be filed with the LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. office.

12. INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF EXHIBITS FOR BOOTHS:

Rendering of service shall comply with all rules and regulations issued by the facility. Arrangements for service may be made through the official show contractor included in the official Exhibitor Service Kit.

13. ELECTRICITY:

Exhibitors shall strictly abide by the rules of the facility as to use of electric supply, including those as to maximum electric current loads for particular exhibit space. No wiring, installation of spotlights or other electrical work shall be done except by electricians employed by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. Exhibitors shall pay to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. \$75.00 PER ELECTRICAL OUTLET Carpenters used by Exhibitors must be approved by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC.

14. SECURITY:

No photographs shall be taken without written authorization of LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. The Exhibitor agrees that LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. may take photographs of the Exhibitor's space, exhibit and exhibit personnel before, during and after the open hours of the Show, for any promotional use by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. Exhibitors and their employees must apply for a resignation badge from LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and wear such badge at all times when in the facility. Badges are not transferable and if transferred to or used by any party other than the individual to whom it was issued, they may be cancelled by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. in its absolute discretion. Neither LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. nor the facility accepts responsibility, nor bailment created, for merchandise or equipment delivered by or to Exhibitors at anytime. Deliveries shall be made only at times specified in the Exhibitors Space Kit. LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and the facility are not responsible for any loss or theft of Exhibitor's merchandise or equipment during any period for the Show or during set-up or dismantling. Exhibitor understands and agrees that LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. security serve, whether in uniform or plainclothes is a presence to inhibit theft, and that LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC., its agents or official suppliers neither offer nor accept responsibility or exhibitor property of any kind.

15. LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. AND THE FACILITY ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR INJURY TO PERSONS OR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF PROPERTY:

Neither LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. nor the facility, their officers, directors, employees, nor the corporate or other entity owning and/or operating the property, nor the representatives of these parties, shall be responsible or liable for injury to any person or for loss or damage to or theft of any property belonging to the participant or any person or persons while in transit to or from the facility or otherwise. The participant shall be and is accountable to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. collectively and individually and to the facility for all damage done to property or person by participant (Exhibitor), their customers, guests, visitors and other persons who enter upon the premises occupied by the participant (Exhibitor) during the show. The participant assumes complete responsibility and the liability of all injury to any and all persons caused by the participant, his agents, representatives, or employees. The participant indemnifies and agrees to hold harmless LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. and the facility, its officers, agents or employees against any and all liability whatsoever arising from any or all damage to property or personal injury caused by participant his agents, representatives, employees or any other persons.

The Exhibitor understands that neither LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. nor the facility, its operators and/or assigns, maintain insurance covering the Exhibitor's property and it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain such insurance.

a) In the event LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. determines to cancel the scheduled exposition prior to the scheduled exposition period because of unforeseen circumstances or because the facility fails or is unable to make the space available, the LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. sole liability shall be the refunding of any participation fees received for the space.

b) If LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. does give or offers to give possession to Participant of assigned display booth(s) or exhibit space or area at the commencement of or at any time during the exposition period or if after Participant be in possession of such space, the exposition operation is interrupted, interfered with or terminated, then in any such event LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. shall be without liability of any kind to the Participants.

16. LIABILITY OF EXHIBITOR:

If exhibitor breaches any term of this agreement including exhibitor obligation to make payments under this agreement and should producer engage counsel or commence legal proceedings against exhibitor, exhibitor shall be responsible for all litigation costs and responsible for attorneys fees.

17. SOLE LIABILITY OF LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC.:

It is understood that in the event there is non-performance by LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. for any reasons whatsoever the maximum liability of LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. under or by virtue of this agreement or otherwise is the refund of the Exhibitor participation fee paid to LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC.

18. SALE OF PRODUCTS AND ORDER TAKING IN THE FACILITY DURING FIRE AND EMS SHOW:

Exhibitors taking orders for on site or future delivery must abide by the sales tax laws of the State of New York. All applicable taxes must be charged and collected by the Exhibitor/Vendor. All Exhibitor/Vendors must have a valid resale authority certificate issued by the State of New York. LONG ISLAND PRODUCTIONS, INC. is not a tax collection agency and as such is unauthorized to collect taxes.
